Our Rooms

Ohinemuri (Early Years) 0 - 3 Year Olds

Our indoor environment is gentle and nurturing and feels like a home away from home. The outdoor environment, on the other hand, is immersive and full of wonderful opportunities for your child to learn and explore. The natural grass and the garden is a much-loved area of our outdoor environment. Both the outdoor and indoor spaces are designed to nurture your child in a safe and secure environment.

Whether it be painting, push and pull toys, blocks, storytelling, sensory play or any other activity, the children are engaged and contributing to the vital early stages of development.



Pukewa

(Kindergarten)

3 - 5 Year Olds

The environment is a mixture of learning opportunities for our tamariki in this room. We provide children with the opportunity to explore, investigate and make discoveries. We enable our children to be active participants in their learning and use their interests to shape the direction of their learning.

Play is the main focus for learning concepts such as language, colours and numbers. Being this age is a time for growth and change and our aim is to extend and support children to guide them towards independence and social competence. We also offer a school readiness program for 4 year old's.



Centre Information

Settling In

Beach Kids Waihi recognises that each child is an individual and when changes take place, we aim to minimise disruption. Every child has a unique way in which they deal with change and when transitioning we accommodate their needs

Beach Kids ensures a smooth transition for children coming to us from home or another centre. We aim to provide parents with support and encouragement, so they will feel confident and reassured about their decision to place their child in our care.

Transition Process

We encourage all parents visit the centre with their child before they start at Beach Kids, so that both the parent and child become comfortable in our space. Once your child is comfortable, we generally ask parents to step away for a period of an hour or so, to see how the child engages with the environment. We will provide feedback of your child's time at Beach Kids. From there, we work with your wishes and desires and move at your pace to transition your child into Beach Kids.

Centre Communication

Beach Kids will commuincate with parents through Storypark when there are planned reviews through the Education Review Office and are welcomed to be activity involved in the review process. Beach Kids will have all policies available for parents/whānau on our website and a copy of the policy handbook is available at the reception area of our centre.

Beach Kids Waihi utilises Storypark to document your child's learning journey of exploration and discovery, and to stay in contact with parents and whānau.

Newsletters are sent monthly via email to update on any special events coming up and exciting things we would like to share.

Decision Making

The decision-making process will reflect sensitivity and respect to different cultural values of the families attending the centre. We operate an open-door policy, where parents and family are welcome into the Centre at any time. We believe decisions should be made consensus involving staff, children, and parents/whānau. In this way people are empowered.





Illness

Exclusion of children with infections and/or disease from early childhood centres is sometimes necessary where there is potential for further spread of infection.

Please notify the centre if your child is unwell or unable to attend by 8am on the day or the day before. Text, call or email the centre manager using the contacts on the back page.

It is important that children are not sent to the centre if ill, or with a contagious or a notifiable disease (eg. conjunctivitis, measles, chicken pox, etc) as we are unable to accept them (this being in compliance with Ministry of Education Regulations and Infectious and Notifiable Diseases Regulations 1996).

The centre manager has the right to refuse a child who may be infectious to other children and staff. This is necessary for the well-being of all the children at the centre.

Abesences

All enrolled days are charged, regardless of whether a child attends or not. Therefore, all sick days are payable. We also do not do day swaps - if your child does not attend a session on a particular day, he / she cannot attend another session during the week to cover. For long term absences please speak to the centre manager.

If your child becomes unwell during the day, we will contact you or your emergency contact to come and collect him/her immediately

Aspirations

We recognise that parents and guardians and whānau have needs and aspirations for their children. Families are given the chance to discuss these needs and aspirations in an atmosphere of respect, understanding, support and warmth. Beach Kids Waihi endeavours to work with parents / guardians and whānau, strengthening the bonds between the centre and the home.

Operating Hours

8.00am - 4.00pm (Monday to Friday)

We are closed on Statutory/Public Holidays. We are closed 1 day of the year in August for a Centre wide trip. This day is not charged.

If we close due to emergency closure you will be notified immediately and that day will not be charged.

Fees

Under 3, Casual and non ECE hours: \$6.50 hour

3 and over with ECE hours:20 hours free (max 6 hours a day*)

Then \$6.50 hour if booking exceeds 20 Hours per week.

*6 hours are to be between the hours of 8:30am and 2:30pm

Invoices are sent weekly to the main bill payers email address on the enrolment form. Fees are sent for the previous weeks sessions and we appreciate accounts to be settled before the next run of invoices are sent.

All permanent bookings are to be paid for whether a child attends or is absent. We rely on regular payments to pay our staff and to provide quality care for your child. Please remember to give us at least two weeks' notice when your child is leaving the centre permanently.

Childcare Subsidy

If you require assistance with completing a WINZ Childcare Subsidy form, our Centre Manager is available on site to guide you through the process. The childcare subsidy forms are conveniently located on the foyer wall for your ease of access. Don't hesitate to ask for help - we're happy to give you a hand!
